

**Arrangement between the Swedish Post and Telecom Authority and the Electronic Communications Office of the Republic of Latvia concerning the coordination of stations in the Land Mobile Service in the frequency bands
450-457.5 MHz / 460-467.5 MHz**

Preamble

According to Article 6 of ITU Radio Regulations, representatives of the Swedish Post and Telecom Authority and the Electronic Communications Office of the Republic of Latvia (hereinafter referred to as the Parties) have concluded this Arrangement concerning the coordination of stations in the Land Mobile Service in the frequency bands 450-457.5 MHz / 460-467.5 MHz (hereinafter referred to as the Arrangement) with the aim of optimizing the use of the frequency bands and avoiding mutual interference on a mutually coordinated basis.

1. Use of frequencies

- 1.1. The Parties agree that mutual coordination of stations in the Land Mobile Service in the frequency bands 450-457.5 MHz / 460-467.5 MHz is not necessary.

2. Procedure

- 2.1. In case of harmful interference to stations in the Land Mobile Service covered by this Arrangement the Party interference come from shall do all necessary measures in order to eliminate the harmful interference to other Party.
- 2.2. Reports of harmful interference shall be presented in accordance to Appendix 10 of the ITU Radio Regulations and processed according to Article 15 of the ITU Radio Regulations.

3. Revision and cancellation

- 3.1. This Arrangement may be revised at any time on the initiative of any Party with the consent of the other Party.
- 3.2. This Arrangement may be cancelled by a mutual decision of both Parties on terms and conditions adopted by the Parties or by a decision of one Party notifying the other Party on its intention at least six months before.

4. Entry into force

- 4.1. This Arrangement shall come into force on the date of signing it by both Parties.
- 4.2. This Arrangement has been drawn in English in two identical copies, one for the Swedish Post and Telecom Authority and one for the Electronic Communications Office of the Republic of Latvia.
