ARRANGEMENT

between the Electronic Communications Office of the Republic of Latvia and the Consumer Protection and Technical Regulatory Authority of the Republic of Estonia

on the use of the frequency band 24,25-27,5 GHz for stations in the land mobile service (IMT) and fixed service in border areas

Preamble

According to Article 6 of ITU Radio Regulations, representatives of the Electronic Communications Office of the Republic of Latvia and the Consumer Protection and Technical Regulatory Authority of the Republic of Estonia (hereinafter referred to as the Parties) have concluded this Arrangement on the use of the frequency band 24.25-27.5 GHz for stations in the land mobile service (IMT1) and fixed service in border areas (hereinafter referred to as the Arrangement) with the aim of optimizing the use of the frequency band on a mutually coordinated basis.

1. Use of frequencies

- The Parties agree that frequency assignments to IMT base stations in the land mobile service do not require coordination in the frequency band 24.25-27.5 GHz if the base stations are located at a distance from borderline not less than 40 km.
- In case of harmful interference to the fixed service stations of the Latvian Party from the 1.2 IMT base stations of Estonian Party in the 24.25-27.5 GHz band, the Estonian Party shall take any measures needed in order to eliminate the harmful interference.

2. Revision and cancellation

- This Arrangement may be revised at any time on the initiative of any Party with the consent of the other Party.
- 2.2 This Arrangement may be cancelled by a mutual decision of both Parties on terms and conditions adopted by the Parties or by a decision of one Party notifying the other Party on its intention at least six months before.

3. Entry into force

- This Arrangement shall come into force on the date of signing it by both Parties.
- This Arrangement has been drawn in English in two identical copies, one for the 3.2 Electronic Communications Office of the Republic of Latvia and one for the Consumer Protection and Technical Regulatory Authority of the Republic of Estonia.
